Upon completion of the class the student will have learned the types of locks that can be picked and be able to apply the best methods to use for these different types of locks. The student should be familiar with the construction and operation of pin Tumbler cylinder, disc tumbler cylinders, and terms used in the ALOA Glossary of Terms Pertaining to Cylinders, Keys & Master Keying. Picks, (hook, diamond, rake, double rake, tension wrenches, (various strength), picking blocks, cyl's with 1 to 6 chambers pinned up, clamps for blocks, pick gun, knob set mounted to demonstrate bumping and bump keys
If you have a MAT lock picking guide by Ted Tool or others on lock picking, Bring it if you wish;
Everyone needs a small vice.
